

The PBIS Committe created many slides to review with the students last week! Students are having a difficult time following some of these expectations.



Valentine's Grams are now on sale in the office for \$1.00. Half of the proceeds will benefit the Maverick Store. The best time to buy is after 3:00 pm.



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
Maverick School Spirit Fridays
