SCHOOL SITE COUNCIL
MEETING MINUTES
February 16, 2021

Welcome and Introductions:

All SSC members were introduced and welcomed to the meeting. No additional guests were present. Zoom meeting norms were reviewed.

Call to Order:

A School Site Council (SSC) meeting was held on February 16, 2021 via a Zoom teleconference.

Ms. DeLaPeña called the meeting to order at 3:03 p.m., a quorum being present.

Approval of Previous Minutes:

The minutes from the November 10, 2020 SSC meeting were reviewed.

Ms. DeLaPeña entertained a motion to approve the November 10, 2020 SSC meeting minutes, Mr. DeOrian made a motion to approve, Mrs. Bradford seconded, and it was unanimously approved.

New Business:

a. Budget Update (Approval Required)

Ms. DeLa Pena made a request to transfer from instructional Materials/Supplies for

PBIS Incentives and Signage in the amount of \$6000. Mrs. Webster made a motion to approve the request, Mr. DeOrian made a second. Mrs. DeLa Pena showed some examples of banners that would be purchased and shared where they could be displayed. The council voted unanimously in favor.

Reports:

a. PAC Report

b. Counselor Overview

We are moving to create a district wide counseling referral. Mrs. Webster discussed the purpose of a school counselor: Academics, Social, emotional wellbeing, and Career interests. Confidentiality regulations were shared. Strong Kids Pilot was discussed. 2 groups are currently being run. Mrs. Webster also shared her yearly goals, all based on student data. She also shared her plan to achieve these goals. The council did not have questions, but Mrs. Bradford shared how the information that Mrs. Webster has distributed has been very helpful

c. ELAC Report

Third meeting is this Thursday at 3:30. ELPAC team is still completing assessments. ELPAC is still scheduled to be given in the Spring. Reading Inventory was given to 100% of the students that were required to take it.

d. Budget Summary Report

The funds for Goals 1-4 were explained. Adjustment for our teacher on special assignment will be made. The \$6000 approved for PBIS will be moved under Goal 2. For Goal 3, monies will be purchased for supplies that need to be sent home for student use. Goal 4, monies have been spent for technology licenses.

e. Attendance has been right about 91%. Last update we were at 644 students.

f. Discipline-suspensions still at 0%. Since September, we have only had 8 discipline referrals.

g. Home Visits 139 YTD. These are triggered by attendance, discipline and rewards.

h. Tier II Interventions: Lexia Core 5 Reading to help with reading gaps. Students not meeting the usage have an average growth of 2 skills. The students meeting the usage have an average growth of 6 skills. Map accelerator in Khan Academy for math is also used. Average usage is 95 minutes.
