General Resources for All Families to help meet basic needs to support families during the COVID-19 Pandemic.

1. Referrals for resources such as food distribution information and emergency resource services are available through the MUSD Centralized Call Center, operating during the school closure from 10:00-2:00, Monday through Friday, 559-416-5858.
2. Establish free or low-cost Internet access
MUSD is able to determine if a home is capable of receiving high-speed internet through Xfinity & then referring them to [Fresno State](#) to apply for low-cost internet services, also offering 60 days free of charge. If their home is not compatible with Xfinity Internet services, the families are placed on a list in which they will be receiving an internet hotspot through MUSD. MUSD students only.
