COURSE: Intro to Humanities

Grades eligible: 9 – 12

Prerequisite: None.

Course Number: 7034

Course Description: *This course is an introduction to the Humanities Careers. The goals of this course are to nurture the interests of the students in the area of the Humanities that encompasses the fine arts, visual, and performing arts. Industry (professionals) will participate in the instruction of the students enrolled. Students will leave with a more defined goal of which fine arts industry they wish to pursue.*

COURSE: Journalism I

Grades eligible: 9 – 12

Prerequisite: Completed or concurrently enrolled in English I

Course Number: 1010

Course Description: *This course teaches the fundamentals of journalism-news features, opinion and sports writing. In addition, students are given fundamental instruction in photography and page layout, paving the way to the Advanced Journalism courses. Students receive practical real world experience by being a part of the Stallion Stampede Staff and producing the MSHS newspaper.*

COURSE: Advanced Journalism (fm Magazine)

Grades eligible: 9 – 12

Prerequisite: A grade of “C” or better in Journalism I Preferred or teacher permission

Course Number: 1336

Students gain experience in producing a monthly publication, containing the student generated writing and visuals (i.e. art, photography).*
