<ul style="list-style-type: none">Selected Elementary schools will host a STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math) and an English Learner Academy. Summer school will be open to students incoming to 3rd grade through incoming to 6th grade. An afterschool program will be available for Elementary Summer School students only. Students attending the English Learner Academy will be taking the CELDT at the end of the program.All Madera Middle Schools will offer Summer School to incoming 7th & 8th grade students. All 7th grade students will receive enrichment classes. Incoming 8th grade students will be offered courses to enrich learning as well as grade replacement opportunitiesHigh School programs will offer Summer School to incoming 9th-12th grade students. Course offerings will include electives, original credit courses, CyberHigh courses and credit recovery opportunities

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
