1. Call to Order

- a. Melody Mouton called the PAC meeting to order at 6:03 p.m.

2. Roll Call – Introduction

- a. Alma Medina took roll. 16 voting PAC members were present at the time of roll call and a quorum was established.

3. Adoption of Agenda

- a. Rafael Flores motioned to approve the agenda. Hilda Vasquez seconded the motion. All members in favor, motion passed.

4. Approval of Minutes

- a. Amendment to the minutes from January 30, 2018, item 7c add: PAC committee is not functioning as the legislature suggests. (per Doug Alton)
- b. Doug Alton motioned to approve the amendment to the minutes from January 30, 2018. Jesse Ochoa seconded the motion. All members in favor, motion passed.
- c. Amendment to the minutes from January 30, 2018, item 6a add: Sherryl Sisil stated that she would address concerns brought by various PAC members in regards to this item.
- d. Sarah Machado motioned to approve the amendment to the minutes from January 30, 2018. Jesse Ochoa seconded the motion. All members in favor, motion passed.

5. Madera Minutes Video

- a. The PAC members viewed the Madera Minutes video highlighting events that took place throughout Madera Unified.
- 6. Receive Volunteer Response Communication from the Director of Community Services. Babatunde Ilori showed video from Superintendent Lile regarding negotiations. It communicates the status of the negotiations happening in MUSD.**
- 7. Presentation LCAP protocols etc.**
 - a. Group was divided in 2 groups to write down ideas of the status of MUSD and the reason why PAC thought only 22% of the students want to come to school. Groups wrote down recommendations.
- 8. Opportunity for public input**
 - a. Among other topics, the PAC discussed:
 - i. Madison DLI enrollment for next year is still opened.
 - ii. Gang interventions needed, lunchtime- no progress from LCAP funding for child nutrition- is there any LCAP funds that can go towards nutrition? Late bus leaves too early, some students cannot participate in afterschool sports.
 - iii. Sheryl Sisil was able to clarify some questions a parent had regarding fingerprinting and being a chaperone. Consistency needed and explanation on the requirements for fingerprinting still need some clarification. Safety protocols still need some clarification. T.J. students need more snacks.
 - iv. Concern about the amount of food being wasted at breakfast time at the schools. Pilot schools should be audited.
 - v. Concern about student safety - parking needed at Dixieland. Security gates and surveillance cameras need to be installed. There is no crosswalk duty staff at school before 7:30 a.m. Not enough staff to help. Tutoring, academic academy needed.
 - vi. Concern that some classes have alternate weeks for music time. Safety concern- the main gate is open all day at Nishimoto.
 - vii. More security guards needed at South high school. Security guards presently are not checking student passes.
 - viii. Parking lot lights are needed at Monroe.
 - ix. La Vina has many old buildings and high windows- student safety concern. Nurse needed $\frac{2}{3}$ days and a counselor is needed more days. Security cameras need to be installed at La Vina.
 - x. Drop off and pick-up area needed at MHS. Shading structures, canopies for sitting areas need to be installed at MHS soon since the weather is changing and Spring is just around the corner.
 - xi. Parking lights are needed at Millview. It's too dark at night.
