



Adhere to dress code outlined in student/district handbook.

Hats/Hoods/Beanies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> California Ed Code Section 35183.5 states that students may wear hats/hoods/beanies in school while <u>outdoors</u> as a means to protect students from the harmful effects of the sun All hats must have a 360 degree brim that circles the entire head and must shade the face No professional or college sports logos are permitted Associated student body hats must conform to established school colors: (e.g. green, white, gray or black)
Shirts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cover mid-drift No professional or college logos No solid red or blue No offensive/inappropriate comments or graphics Covers all undergarments and chest areas Tank tops must have straps wide enough to cover undergarments (minimum of at least two-fingers wide)
Shorts/Skirts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must be mid-thigh or longer (or have leggings that are mid-thigh underneath) No holes above mid-thigh Must cover all undergarments No sagging; all shorts/skirts must be worn at the waist
Pants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must be mid-thigh or longer (or have leggings that are mid-thigh underneath) Must cover all undergarments No sagging; all pants must be worn at the waist
Shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must have back strap No flip flops No all red or blue shoes/laces No slippers/house shoes
Logos	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No professional or college sports logos on any item (e.g. lanyards, binders, backpacks, clothing, etc.)
Piercing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Earrings may only be worn in <u>stud</u> ears [No piercings are allowed in noses, lips, eyebrows, tongue, etc.] Sharp studs are not permitted
Pajamas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not to be worn at school
Blankets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not to be brought to school
Hair	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Color streaks must be a natural hair color (e.g. Black, Brown, Blonde) No designs may be edged into hairlines Faux hawk must be under 3 inches
Gang Related	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not allowed on any articles of clothing, accessories, or materials
Belts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No red or blue belts No dangling ends No initials
Accessories or Jewelry	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cannot pose SAFETY OR HEALTH CONCERN (e.g. studded/spiked bracelets, earrings or necklaces)

Sombreros/Capuchas/ Gorro de lana	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> La sección del código de educación de California 35183.5 declara que los alumnos pueden llevar cachuchas/suavadoras con gorro/gorro de lana en la escuela mientras estén <u>afuera</u> para proteger a los alumnos de los efectos dañinos del sol No se permiten logotipos de deportes o de universidades Las cachuchas del cuerpo estudiantil asociado debe adaptarse a los colores escolares establecidos: (por ejemplo, verde, blanco, gris o negro)

Cabello	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rayos de colores están bien No se pueden hacer diseños en el corte de cabello Halcón tipo imitación de remos de 3 paletadas está bien No se permite en ningún artículo de ropa, accesorio o material
