





The Parent Project / Loving Solutions program is a community-based parenting skills program adopted in Madera County.

The program works directly with parents to help improve children's school attendance and performance, reduce family conflict, and develop strong in-home strategies for gang prevention. Loving Solutions is geared towards parents with children in the ages of 5-10 years old.

An In-person cohort was hosted at Madison Elementary School during the 2021-2022 school year. The school site reported major improvement in the behavior of those students whose parents graduated from the program.

Workshops are engaging, practical and avaiable at times that are convenient for our parent community.








