Metaphor	Comparing two unlike things without using like or as	Your eyes are pools of deep blue water.
Idiom	A word phrase with a different meaning than what the words say.	It's raining cats and dogs.
Onomatopoeia	Words that sound like the object they name or the sounds those objects make.	Buzz!
Personification	Giving human traits to nonhuman things	The sailboat danced on the waves.
Alliteration	The repetition of the same beginning letter or sound.	The willows were whispering in the wind.
Hyperbole	Uses extreme exaggeration to make a point or for emphasis.	My backpack weighs a ton!
