Level B is the goal, over half 49% were reading at grade level, went down one present in 2019 but then came back up in 2020. Do have the ability to see where other schools are at in MUSD and Parkwood in comparison is the highest. It is exciting to see results. More work to be done obviously and they will be taking the test one more time before the end of the school. Kinder takes it twice a year.

• NWEA Maps 3-6 grade. Two areas - Reading and Math- Comparing Last year in the Fall and this year in the Fall. For example 4th grade grew 8 points. This test is similar to the State test. 6 grade grew 5 points and needed 6 points. Closing the gap. Teachers are working hard to provide that solid good first instruction to get students on track.

Lexia- Reading program. Helps students learn to read. Lexia is a computer base program to
address literacy skills students need support in. Lessons are built in to support the student.
Number of students reading below grade level 311. Give you an idea how students are
performing overall in our school.

## ii. PBIS Update

• Positive Behavior Intervention Support - Team of teachers that work together to support behaviors. Implementing for 3 years. Staff are very familiar. Our work has been a little different diving into PBIS. Dr. Hannigin, she is a PBIS support for our site. The challenge has been in our Distance Learning environment. Developed a Matrix that we developed to share with Parents, Teacher, and Staff. Built to support the PAWS. Teachers have been doing a good job teaching those expectations. We are getting better results from students with their behavior. Self concepts are also taught. We see how in this distance learning environment they are having struggles reaching out for help So the lessons are given to support those needs. We are collecting data with surveys pre and post on the area of self concepts. With the SIPSA one of our goals is to work on the metal well being of students.
