Saturday Intervention

On the last two Saturday's of the semester, Dec. 7th & 14th, Mt. Vista was able to offer four hours of Intervention time for our students to focus on making up work, preparing for assessments, and making up credits. Thank you to all the staff that came in to make this opportunity available to our students. As we move forward into next semester, we are planning on offering this opportunity once a term, providing staff are available. Please encourage your student to take advantage of the four full hours of intervention to complete their assignments and to have the opportunity to receive 0.5 credit toward their elective requirement.

Intervención del Sabado

After School Program

Another option for student credit recovery is the After School Program. The After School Program works closely with the school counselor, teachers, administration and staff to get students on track to graduate. The Mountain Vista After School Program offers a positive environment for students to catch up on their credits, do their homework as well as have a safe place to be around their peers. To help your student achieve these goals they are expected to attend on a regular basis. Students are also expected to keep passing grades and exceptional behavior to attend any field trip ASP may have.

Student Health Wellness/Salud del Estudiante

Family Life and Drivers Education

Beginning next semester, your son/daughter may be entering our Family Life Program which is taught in conjunction with Drivers Education as part of their PE class. The Family Life component is an 8 week course. The Family Life Curriculum is designed to aid your son/daughter with real life topics which may affect them on a daily basis. A form is being mailed home with this monthly newsletter that explains in more detail what the course will focus on. If parents decide they don't want their student(s) to participate in the section for sexual health, then you can use this form to opt out of this portion of the class. **Parents will need to indicate this on the form, sign and date, and return the completed form to MVHS main office. The deadline for returning this form is Jan. 15th.**

Vida Familiar y Educación Para Conductores

A partir del próximo semestre, es posible que su hijo / a ingrese a nuestro Programa de vida familiar que se imparte junto con la Educación para conductores como parte de su clase de educación física. El componente de vida familiar es un curso de 8 semanas. El plan de estudios de la vida familiar está diseñado para ayudar a su hijo / a con temas de la vida real que pueden afectarlos a diario. Se envía un formulario a casa con este boletín mensual que explica con más detalle en qué se centrará el curso. Si los padres deciden que no quieren que sus estudiantes participen en la sección de salud sexual, entonces puede usar este formulario para optar por no participar en esta parte de la clase. **Los padres deberán indicar esto en el formulario, firmar y fechar, y devolver el formulario completo a la oficina principal de MVHS. La fecha límite para devolver este formulario es el 15 de Enero.**

Reminder: Attendance Policy/Politica de Asistencia

California compulsory education law requires everyone between the ages of six and eighteen years of age to attend school. If you have three or more unexcused absences from school, you will be considered "truant". Your parents will be notified by mail with a truancy notice. If you have six or more unexcused days from school you may be declared a "habitual truant" and referred to the MUSD School Attendance and Review Board. Your School attendance is the first predictor of school success. Plan to be at school EVERY DAY. School attendance is reviewed daily. Students will not be successful in their academic achievement without regular attendance.
