

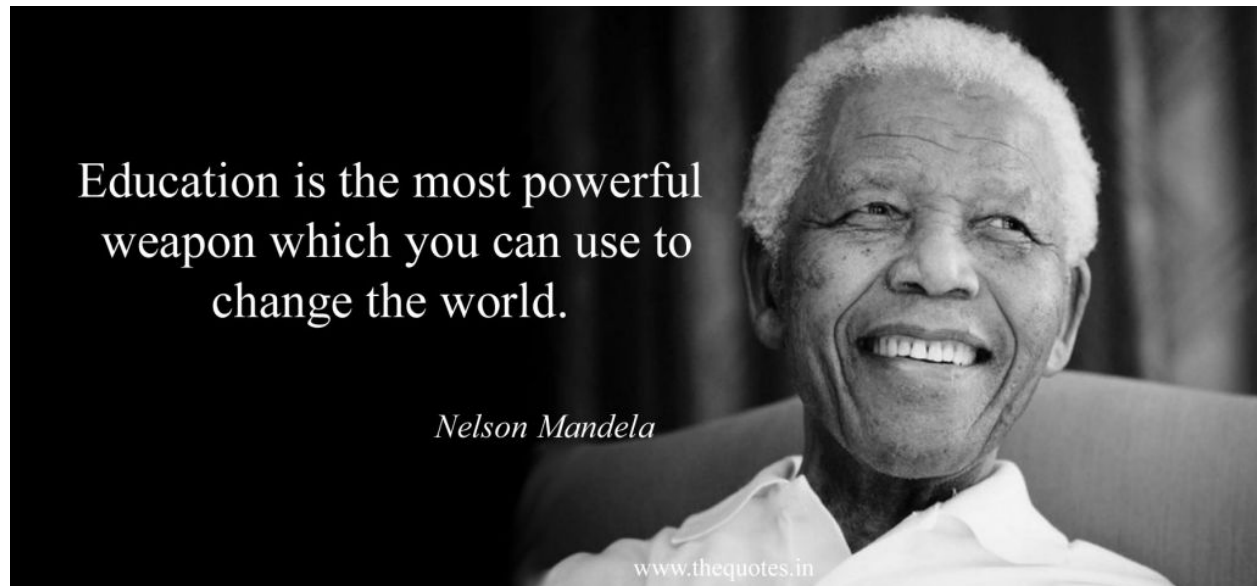

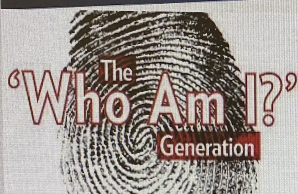

Staff Highlight

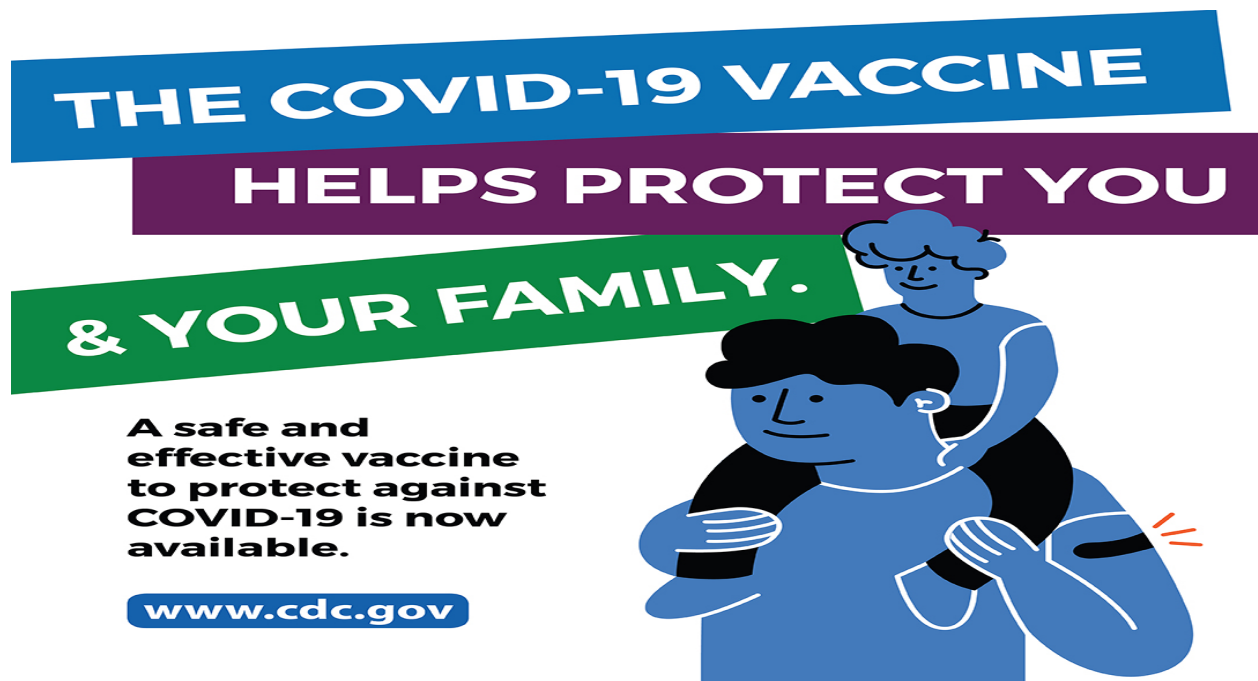


The above picture of the Curriculum and Instruction Committee was taken in 2019.
