7A. Public Hearing

President Westley opened the meeting for visitors to speak on a subject not on the Board Agenda.

No one present came forward.

5. <u>New Business</u>

5A. Public hearing for Charter School Development Systems' petition seeking approval of their on-line e-charter school within Madera Unified School District

President Westley opened the Public Hearing for Charter School Development Systems' petition at 6:05 p.m. President Westley then outlined the process for the hearing and asked Superintendent Stafford to introduce the petition submitted to the District. President Westley then invited the petitioners to make their presentation.

Mr. Blaise Subbiondo of eTAP, Inc. (Teaching Assistance Program) was present on behalf of the petitioners. Mr. Subbiondo presented a handout of a slide presentation to Mr. Stafford and each member of the Board and proceeded to give a brief overview of their program.

Following Mr. Subbiondo's presentation President Westley opened the floor for public comment.

Alice Rios, CSEA Chapter President and Madera Unified employee spoke on behalf of Madera Unified School District's classified employees in opposition to the charter petition submitted by Charter School Development Systems citing a lack of understanding of the particular needs and issues of Madera Unified students by an East coast corporation and their failure to fully comply with the laws of the State of California.

Babette Jaire, MUTA President spoke on behalf of the Madera Unified Teacher Association in opposition to the charter petition submitted by Charter School Development Systems citing a lack of WASC accreditation and access to wet labs for science experiments.

Bob Amaro, Madera Unified School District Attendance Officer spoke in opposition to the charter petition submitted by Charter School Development Systems citing a lack of oversight/supervision of students who may enroll in this program.

There were no further public comments.

President Westley closed the floor to public comment and allowed Mr. Subbiondo to respond to comments made by the public and asked for clarifying questions from the Board.

Mr. Subbiondo addressed the issue of WASC accreditation by stating this was a simple process of applying for accreditation and commented that they do have a couple of experiments that students will be able to perform at home in place of wet labs.

The Board asked clarifying questions which Mr. Subbiondo responded to.

President Westley stated that the Board will reconvene at a later date to further consider, discuss, and take action on the petition within 60 days from receipt of the petition by Madera Unified from Charter School Development Systems.
