SYSTEM PROGRAMMING FOR COACH'S SWITCH USE:

IN ORDER FOR THE CONTROL SYSTEM WITH A FLOW SENSOR/MASTER VALVE INSTALLATION TO ASSOCIATE FLOWS WITH A PARTICULAR STATION AND TO DETERMINE THAT THE FLOWS ARE NOT UNAUTHORIZED WHICH MAY RESULT IN A MASTER VALVE SHUT-DOWN, SET UP THE SYSTEM AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. NAME AN UNUSED STATION ON A FIELD CONTROLLER "COACH'S SWITCH".
- 2. AT THE CONTROLLER, OR THE CENTRAL BASE STATION, SET THE MAXIMUM FLOW FOR THE COACH'S SWITCH STATION TO A VALUE HIGHER THAN THE EXPECTED FLOW FROM THE SKINNED INFIELD ZONE(S) WHEN OPERATING.
- 3. CREATE A CONTROLLER PROGRAM AS "COACH'S SWITCH PROGRAM 1".
- 4. SET THE PROGRAM 'START TIME' FOR THE EARLIEST TIME THE COACH'S SWITCH MAY BE USED, E.G. 8:00 AM.
- 5. SET THE PROGRAM 'RUN TIME' FOR THE MAXIMUM LENGTH OF TIME THAT THE COACH'S SWITCH MAY BE USED, E.G. 8:00 AM TO 6:00 PM = 10 HOURS.
- 6. SET THE PROGRAM 'DAY SCHEDULE' FOR THE DAYS THAT THE COACH'S SWITCH MAY BE USED.
- CONSIDER CREATING ADDITIONAL COACH'S SWITCH PROGRAMS (2, 3, ETC.) TO COVER NIGHT GAMES, WEEKEND SCHEDULES OR OTHER SPECIAL EVENTS IF DIFFERENT FROM THE STANDARD PROGRAM.
