5b. Action Item: National Healthy Schools Award Applications – Review all MUSD Comprehensive Schools and Establish Next Steps

- Jaime Brown will be working with Caitlin Pendley and Amanda Massetti to support the Health Services department with Alliance for a Healthier Generation Healthy Schools Program assessment completion and award applications. Most employees do not know the detailed services and assessments provided to students/employees in MUSD due to privacy laws, therefore Health Services has agreed to take over this assessment/award item moving forward. This will ensure that the health services sections are accurate for all comprehensive MUSD schools. Also, nurses provide several services that are "fully in place" on the healthy schools assessment and deserve the opportunity to become possible award recipients in the "Supporting School Health Services" category for all school sites.
- The Physical Education department is currently completing award applications for the following sections for their schools: "Implementing Local School Wellness Policy" and "Bolstering Physical Education and Activity".
