 - 1: Score a 4 on the ELPAC
 - 2: Score a C- or better in their Report Card for Reading, Writing, Spelling, and ELD
 - 3: Parent Input
 - 4: NWEA Reading Fluency Scores for Grades K-2 and Reading Inventory Scores for Grades 3-6
- B. English Learner data
 - i. Students tested
 - There are 658 students at Monroe
 - 61 students are ELIAC
 - 285 are EL Students

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ii. ELPAC results

- There were 285 EL Students who took the ELPAC Test
- Grades TK-2: Are Awaiting Results
- Grade 3: 8/46 Scored a 4
- Grade 4: 5/36 Scored a 4
- Grade 5: 11/33 Scored a 4
- Grade 6: 4/28 Scored a 4
- There are 28 students in grades 3-6 that will be reclassified and we are still waiting for the Scores for Grades TK-2
