
Madera Induction Consortium Changes Since 2021

The Madera Induction Consortium has undergone several systematic changes since the spring of 2021.

- MUSD has begun to transition from part-time mentors to full time mentors. All beginning teachers in the Madera Induction Consortium (MIC) receive at least one hour of mentoring per week outside of their duty day. Beginning teachers in Madera Unified School District (MUSD) who are assigned a Teacher Support Mentor (TSM) are given additional support. TSM meet with their mentees 4 to 6 hours per week. The one-hour induction mentoring requirement per week is met during this time. In addition to the one hour per week induction mentoring these teachers, as part of MUSD work requirements for beginning teachers, receive additional support.
