Vista–89,000 for teacher salary (Reading Lab, SEL Prep, 7th period credit recovery), \$40,000 in materials, remaining \$49,000</li> <li>Progress is discussed, per Panorama survey positive school climate is up</li> <li>Engagement has increased from Fall 21 to Spring of 23</li> <li>Grad rates increasing from 2019 to 2023, 38.4% to 73%</li> </ul>		



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<ul> <li>Question: if students take a college course, can money be used for books/tuition/transportation</li> <li>Possible Career fair- t-shirts</li> <li>5 Star application—scanning IDs, has virtual store aspect, yearly fees</li> <li>Leadership class possibilities: conferences, curriculum, committees—possible 0/7 period</li> <li>CSI: rewards/awards, limitations to spending money</li> <li>Monterey Trip, other day trips</li> <li>Sacramento Trip on train</li> <li>CPR/First Aid through CTE with Jones, certification needs to be paid by student</li> <li>McDermont X (1000 bus/ 30 kid) 4-5 hours, 9am to closing, PE standards, In Lindsay 1.5 hours from Madera.</li> <li>Attendees discussed possible requirements for attending McDermont X: pass all classes, minimum of 5 credits in each class.</li> </ul>
