9A. Request approval of School Site Plans for the 2010/11 school year

Marisa DiMauro presented an overview of the 2010/11 School Site Plans. The Board asked clarifying questions, and discussed the concerns and expectations for the 2010/11 school year:

School Site Councils – Educating each School Site Council of the District's expectations; School Site Plans have been developed to meet state and federal guidelines and targets; therefore, are mandatory, not optional. Agendas and minutes for School Site Council meetings must be posted on each school website according to mandated timelines. Parent Education through communication to keep them informed and empowered in the education of their child/children.

Career Schools – Site plans didn't include the vision or direction for the career schools. The District needs to regain the mission of the career schools and communicate the expectations to the high school administrators. Suggestions from the Board to move in this direction: workshops, scheduled tours of career schools for Board members, career school advisory committee and meetings.

Language Star – The Board would like to see the implementation of Language Star in all of the elementary sites. The clarification was made to the Board that implementation at all sites, is not a budget issue, but a personnel issue. Allocation of personnel to coach teachers to use Language Star is limited. Educational Services is refining the model of what elementary Language Star should be.

It was moved by Trustee Salvador, seconded by Trustee Westley, and unanimously carried to approve the School Site Plans for the 2010/11 school year.
