



Student perception of physical and psychological safety at school - based on 3,420 responses











Family's perceptions of physical and psychological safety at school based on **1,413** responses.






#### **3rd-5th School Climate**

Student perceptions of the overall social and learning climate of the school Based on 3,420 responses.




#### 6th-12th School Climate

Perceptions of the overall social and learning climate of the school based on **8,170** responses.










## **3rd-5th School Belonging**

How much student feel that they are valued members of the school community - 3,420 Responses.




## **6th-12th School Belonging**











- 2022-23 school year began with a district-wide focus on being a "Student Champion".
- All sites and departments focused on cultivating socially, emotionally, physically safe and positive school environments.
- Approximately 2100 MUSD employees (classified and certificated) attended Day One of the Student Champion Course.
- Of 983 employees who complete the event surveyed after Day One, 94% gave favorable responses and 85% were "satisfied" or "very satisfied" with the course.
