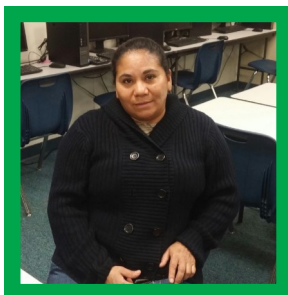
PARENT CAFÉ — PROMOTES PARENT ENGAGEMENT
