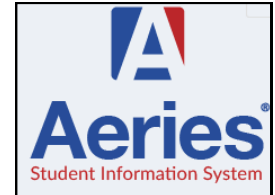

## MUSD MOVING TO AN ONLINE REGISTRATION PROCESS IN PREPARATION OF THE 2016-2017 SCHOOL YEAR.

In order for parents/guardians to register current students for the 2016-17 school year, parents must have an MUSD Aeries Parent Portal Account. This account will also allow access to view student(s) current attendance and grades.



**NOTE: This process does not apply to those students who are NEW to Madera Unified. There is a separate process for new student registration and anyone who falls under this category should contact their school site.**

The following information is required prior to creating a Parent Portal Account:

- Email Account
- Student Permanent Identification Number
- Valid Area code and Telephone Number  
*(Visit your school site if you do not have a telephone number)*
- Verification Pass Code

### Instructions to register online:

1. **Open an internet browser and go to [www.madera.k12.ca.us](http://www.madera.k12.ca.us)**
  - Click on "Check My Child's Grades—Aeries Parent Portal"
  - Create a NEW PARENT account by following the directions on the screen.
2. **Accessing Student Information**
  - Once logged in, you will be given access to a number of tabbed choices including student attendance and grades. A link to change Password and Logout is located at the top left corner of the screen. **Please note:** All information is current. You will be able to view and/or print any of the information.
3. **Logging Out**
  - The Parent Portal will automatically log you out after 20 minutes of inactivity. It is important that you log out and close the internet browser when you have finished to prevent others to access your student's personal records to users of the computer after you.
