Laptop Lab Rules for Students

Students should handle all laptop computers with <u>extreme care</u>.

Using laptops in your classroom is a <u>privilege</u>

- 1. Absolutely no gum, candy or drinks in the classroom. If anyone in a group has gum or candy or drinks, the computers will be put away for that group.
- 2. All backpacks must be placed under the desks before the laptops are taken out of the mobile lab. Students are not allowed to get into their backpacks during the time the computers are out. Pencils and notebooks should be the only things on the desks. <u>DO NOT pick up a backpack</u>; laptops are easily knocked to the floor when backpacks are moved.
- 3. Students are not allowed to be out of their seats during the time the laptops are out without permission.
- 4. All laptops are to be on the desk not on top of other books. They must be placed in the center of <u>ONE</u> desk and not on the edge. When sharing a computer place it securely in the middle of <u>ONE</u> desk.
- 5. Students are not allowed to touch the screen with anything.
- 6. The laptop Keys will pop off and cannot be replaced. Do not play with the keys.
- 7. If something goes wrong with your laptop computer, immediately notify the teacher.
- 8. If students go to any web site other than what teachers have determined should be be used, they have violated the Internet Use Agreement contract they signed and therefore will not be allowed to use a computer in the classroom again.
