## 7. Reports

### a. ELPAC Testing

- In grades 3-6, there are 65 in person EL students and 70 DL EL students
- Most student have completed all 4 sections of the ELPAC
- There are 6 students that need 1 or more sections to make up
- 2nd Grade ELPAC testing is scheduled for 5/20 & 5/21.
- There are 28 (26 attended) in person EL students and 23 (23 attended) DL EL students
- 2nd Graders will be administered 3 sections of 5/20, with the last section of writing to be administered on 5/21 (each section is about 15-20 minutes long)

### b. NWEA Testing

- CAASPP Testing will not be implemented this school year
- The local NWEA test is in lieu of the CAASPP
- 3rd & 4th Grade began the Reading Section on 5/17.
- 5th & 6th Grade began the Reading Section on 5/20
- 3rd - 6th will begin the math section of the assessment the week of 5/24

- Monroe celebrated Salute to Education Week by providing lunch to the entire staff on 5/12. To celebrate the parents and students, the school gave out treats in front of the school on 5/14.
- We Believe Champion was awarded to Sonia Dhillon on 5/19. The entire staff, as well as her family, were invited to surprise and honor Sonia for her dedication and hard work. (District award that is given to someone who is a champion for kids at each school site)
- There have been several Wednesday’s Wellness Walks from 11:00 - 11:30 am. The entire staff is invited to come outside and walk a preset course around the school. They are then invited to have a healthy snack. This is all organized and led by the Monroe Wellness Committee.
- Teachers and grade levels are preparing for end of the school year activities. This includes final testing and grades, fun end of the year activities, awards assemblies, and a big send off for our 6th graders!
