- (1) A workshop on proposed trustee area redistricting maps will be held on Tuesday, February 8, 2022, at 6:45 p.m. or as soon thereafter as possible, as part of the regular meeting of the Board.
- (2) A public hearing to consider the adoption of a new trustee area map will be held on Tuesday, February 22, 2022, at 6:45 p.m. or as soon thereafter as possible, as part of the regular meeting of the Board.
