Meeting Minutes #4: Monday, March 20th, 2023

- I. **Call the meeting to order** *The meeting was called to order at 3:11 PM*
- II. **Call for additions/deletions of agenda items** There were no additions or deletions.
- III. **Reading and approval of minutes** No changes were necessary to the minutes from the previous meeting
- IV. **New Business:**
 - A. There are currently 186 students enrolled at Eastin Arcola. 69 of those students are ELLs, 76 are EO, 9 students are IFEPs and 30 students have been reclassified. Our goal as a school is for all of the ELL students to be reclassified before they go to middle
 - B. Mrs. Alvarado explained that parents whose children are classified as ELLS have the option of opting out of the English Program. If parents feel that their children do not need the extra support, this is an option for them.
 - C. Mrs. Alvarado explained that the district continues to hold community meetings to take suggestions on how to spend the funds from Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP). The LCAP is a three-year plan that describes the goals, actions, services, and expenditures to support positive student outcomes that address state and local priorities. The LCAP provides an opportunity for local educational agencies (LEAs) to share their stories of how, what, and why programs and services are selected to meet their local needs.
 - D. Students will be taking the NWEA in place of the SBAC testing. The testing window is from April 17th to May 19th.
 - E. ELPAC: Students in 3rd -8th grade were tested on March 7th. Kindergarten -2nd grade will be tested on May 3rd by the district team.
