**Participation Guidelines:**

- The implementation of the curriculum begins in September with lessons in Digital Citizenship (3-4 lessons).
- Second Step Curriculum consists of one lesson per week.
  - Grades K-6: 20-30 minutes/lesson
  - Grades 7-8: 50 minutes/lesson
- Lessons are to be taught according to the pacing calendar.
- For K-6/K-8 Schools:
  - Each site will designate the day and time schoolwide that the curriculum will be taught (All grades: same day/same time).
  - Second Step may not be taught during core instruction (i.e. ELA, ELD, Math, Science, & History/Social Science).
  - Progress monitoring chart should be posted. Chart should be dated as lessons are taught each week. (Charts will be sent to sites at the beginning of the school year.)
- For Middle Schools:
  - Second Step curriculum will be taught in Grade 7 & 8 Social Science class.
  - Each site will designate the day the curriculum will be taught.
  - Progress monitoring chart should be posted. Chart should be dated as lessons are taught each week. (Charts will be sent to sites at the beginning of the school year.)
